# Whoa Miranda... NOW THAT'S A SPLIT!

The couple soldier on amid a flurry of hurtful gossip

**S**tepping out hand in hand at the Golden Globes, Miranda Kerr and Orlando Bloom seemed determined to silence rumours of a split.

The A-listers celebrated Orlando's 36th birthday at the awards, with Miranda, 29, dazzling in a Zuhair Murad gown with a high-high slit, which captivated her husband.

'They are truly happily married,' Miranda's grandmother Ann Kerr assured *New Idea*. The type of work they do does separate them. But before Miranda got married she and Orlando knew that would be the case.'

The couple - on a rare date night without son Flynn, two - looked loved-up arriving at the Warner Bros and *InStyle* after-party at the Beverly Hilton.

Miranda posted several snaps on her Instagram social media page, including one of her hubby's dessert

with a 'happy birthday' message. The unified display comes after weeks of speculation that their two-and-a-half year marriage is all but over. They spent much of last year apart while Orlando filmed *The Hobbit* in New Zealand and crime thriller *Zulu* in South Africa.

Meanwhile, Miranda was spotted with Leonardo DiCaprio in New York on several occasions, prompting talk that she and Orlando had 'drifted apart'.

The rumours - denied by Miranda's rep - come amid reports Orlando is furious over the model repeatedly Tweeting sexy photos to her fans. A source tells *Now* magazine Orlando feels Miranda should 'think about how Flynn will react when he's older'.

Body language expert Susan Constantine analysed the Globes photos of the star pair and also has concerns for their future.

'Miranda's the front runner, who is more dominant,' Susan says. 'If they are going to remain a couple, they need to enjoy experiences together. **M**



'Miranda's hand is stretched out far from her body, holding Orlando's hand in a dominant position,' says body language expert Susan Constantine. 'There's a lot of space between them. He's in a more submissive position, showing he feels a bit insecure.'

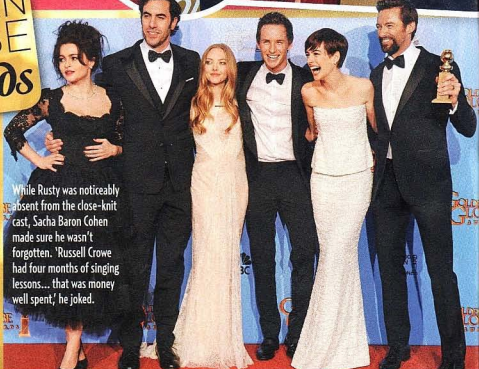
## Where's Russ?
