Day at the U.S. Open marred by misery

THE tennis pros at center court weren't the only combatants in New York City Sept. 12 — Michael Douglas and wife Catherine Zeta-Jones also went to war in the stands!

A family outing to the U.S. Open turned into a scene worthy of Michael's black comedy about a crazed divorcing couple, "War of the Roses," with the superstars viciously tearing into each other in public!

The humiliating scene renewed fears they are headed for another split, sources told *The National ENQUIRER*!

Accompanied by their 12-year-old daughter, Carys, and 15-year-old son, Dylan, Michael and Catherine were trying to watch the women's final, but as these exclusive photos show, it was far from a picture of family harmony.

Trouble began brewing when the couple grabbed coffee and snacks in their exclusive viewing suite, a source said.

"Michael and Catherine came out and sat their things down on a high countertop before going to their seats, but you could already hear and see them sniping at each

other," the source said.

"It seemed like Catherine was goading him — she was laughing at him and Michael's face turned angry.


"They eventually went down to their first-row seats, but it seemed like an hour before they said anything to each other; Michael was looking one way, Catherine the other. You could feel the tension between them."

"I feel sorry for Michael Douglas," Susan Constantine, author of "The Complete Idiot's Guide to Reading Body Language," said. "I can't tell

you what they're saying, but it's clear she's in his face and punishing him!"

Each photo tells the same story to Susan. "Michael appears submissive in these shots, while Catherine is domineering and combative. He's constantly looking away in avoidance of her abuse," she explained.

The very public spat marks another downturn in a rocky 14-year marriage between Michael, 71, and Catherine, 46. They separated in May 2013, after she sought treatment for bipolar disorder. **NE**
